

RECOLLECTIONS OF NATURE is by landscape painter of the West, David Vollbracht. Vollbracht works primarily in oils and has a special fondness for prairie and mountain settings. A strong representational painter that incorporates some impressionistic techniques, Vollbracht tries to communicate the emotion he felt at the scene in his paintings. He allows himself artistic liberties in directing compositional flow, so he can draw viewers in and guide them completely through the work. David is most captivated by light; especially by the patterns and shapes natural light creates in the outdoors. He is a studio and plein air painter who has shown his work nationally. A highlight of his 35-year professional painting career is becoming a *Signature Member of the Oil Painters of America*. David's work has been in numerous shows including: Mountain Oyster Club Show, Tucson, AZ; One Man Show Wichita Center for the Arts, Wichita, KS; National Miniature Show, La Luz, NM; Rocky Mountain Plein Air Show, Winter Park, CO; and National Oil Painters of America Exhibitions. The Dane G. Hansen Museum was recently honored to be the recipient of Kate and Alpha Hansen's bedroom suite, a generous gift from Carol Bales. This beautiful Bird's Eye Maple 8-piece suite was purchased in 1909 by Mr. and Mrs. Peter Hansen for the bedroom of Dane Hansen's sisters, Kate and Alpha. The suite consists of a bed, bedside table, dresser with vanity bench, wash stand, rocking chair, desk and chair. The desk and chair were gifted specifically to Alpha Hansen (Bales), grandmother of D.G. Bales, Jr. In 1975, Dane and Polly Bales had the bedroom suite refinished so their son D.G. could use this Hansen heirloom in his home. This stunning suite now permanently resides in the Hansen Family History portion of the Museum.



REALISM AND HYPERREALISM IN CONTEMPORARY AUTOMOBILE AND MOTORCYCLE PAINTING

An exhibition of over 55 paintings by 15 of today's realists and hyperrealists artists who specialize in automobiles and motorcycles as their primary subjects of choice. Their work exemplifies the very best of today's automotive painting and builds on the first wave of photo-realists in the '60's and '70's. LUSTER encompasses a broad range of cars and motorcycles from vintage vehicles from the 1940's and before to more recent classics. During the post-World War II boom years, cheap gas and the advent of the Interstate Highway System in 1956 propelled automotive design and sales. In the 1950s, the industry reached new heights by offering consumers increased horse power for thrust and speed, and more artfully, integrated design which was dramatized in the 1960's with features such as tail fins. LUSTER features paintings of passenger automobiles from those boom years and since, plus a range of motorcycles and racing vehicles.
