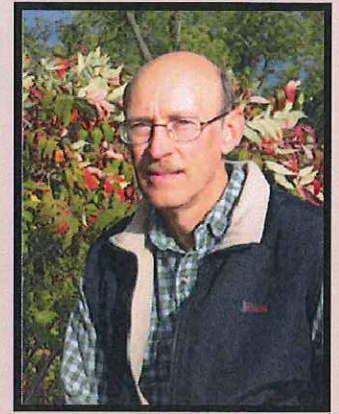


David Vollbracht

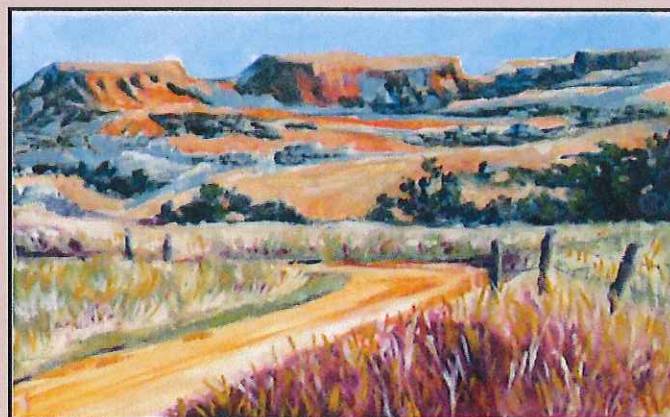

Oil Paint:

- *Titanium White
- *Cadmium Yellow Light
- *Yellow Ochre
- *Viridian Green
- *Ultramarine Blue
- *Alizarin Crimson
- *Cadmium Red Lt.

(If you do not have all of these
bring what you have or what you
use on your palette.)

Other:

- *Bring at least 5 good quality
photographs of landscape
- *Sketch book and a no.2 pencil
- *Odorless turpentine (Turpenoid)
and a container to wash out brushes
- *Brushes - various sizes
(bring what you have)
- *Tear away strip palette for mixing paint
- *Canvas - 8"x10" or 16"x20"-
at least one for each day
- *Paper towels

One morning we will sketch en plein air, and from the sketch develop a small oil painting in the classroom.
