Museum Updates

Renovations:

Refreshed Kitchen & Bathrooms:

Thank you in advance for your patience as we begin giving the building a little extra TLC. We will start renovating the bathrooms and Community Room kitchen in the near future, and plan to complete the project before February 2020. We are exploring a full-scale renovation of the museum and will be meeting with designers in late October.

41st Annual Labor Day Celebration:

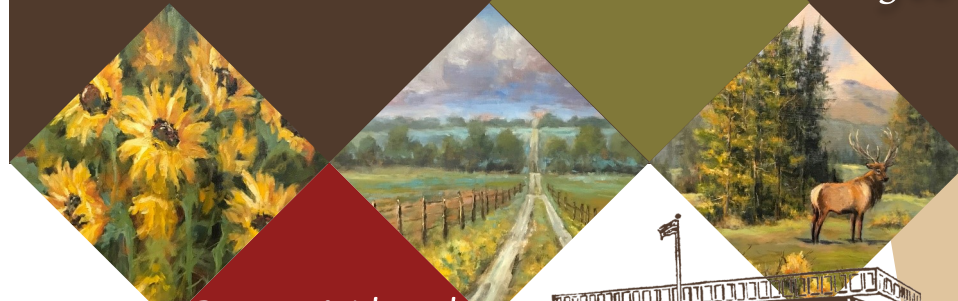
