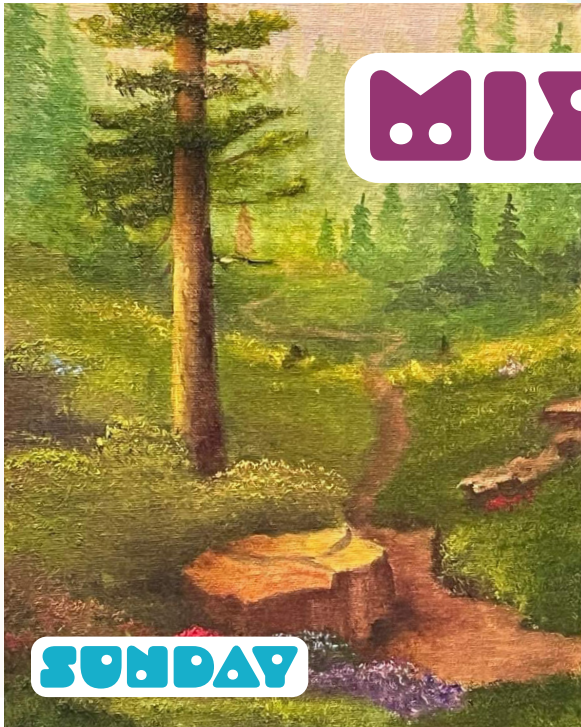

REQUIRED MATERIALS

- Easel, Palette, Brushes, Odorless Thinner, Red ink pen (not gel), #2 Pencil, Styrofoam plates, Containers for water and thinner, Paper towels, Q-tips, 11x14 Canvas
- Acrylics: True Green, Christmas Green, Bright Yellow, Bright Blue, Burnt Umber, Nutmeg Brown, Black
- Oils: Liquid Clear or Liquin, Titanium White, Sap Green, Med Yellow, Burnt Umber, Burnt Sienna, Phthalo Blue or Prussian Blue, Alizarin Crimson, Yellow Ocher, Dioxazine Purple
- Brushes: 1" Regular Brush, 1" Bristle Brush, Medium Round, Small Round or Script Liner, Bristle Fan Brush.

Beginner Friendly: A light & lively learning atmosphere where painters explore different mediums. **June 8 & 9** from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm in the Museum Community Room.

Each day, instructor **Sandy Seamone** will guide participants step-by-step through a painting using both acrylic and oil paints. **See supply lists.** Ideal for all painting levels.

- Oils: Grambacker First Coat Clear or Bob Ross Liquid Clear, or Winsor Newton Liquin
- Same brushes as Sunday (see right).
*using acrylic paints to get watercolor look
